

A Guide to Leaving a Gift in Your Will to Pillars

One of the ways that you can help Pillars in the future, is to leave a bequest in your will. This is a simple process which will ensure that Pillars has the funding to enable the valuable work of the last 30 years to be continued.

Your legacy will enable children who have limited opportunities through no fault of their own, to succeed and prosper.

A bequest can be given for a specific purpose or for general use. It can be a specific amount or percentage of your estate. It can also be property or an asset.

A bequest can be prepared at any time, at any age whether you include it when planning your will or add it later.

If you decide to leave a bequest to Pillars, we recommend you ask your solicitor to make the necessary changes to your will. You could ask them to use the following paragraph draft especially for a bequest.

“I give to Pillars Incorporated, the sum of \$..... (or a percentage of my estate, or a description of the property of asset given) for its general purposes or the specific purpose of and declare that the receipt of the Chief Executive of Pillars or any other proper officer shall be sufficient discharge for my Trustee”.
